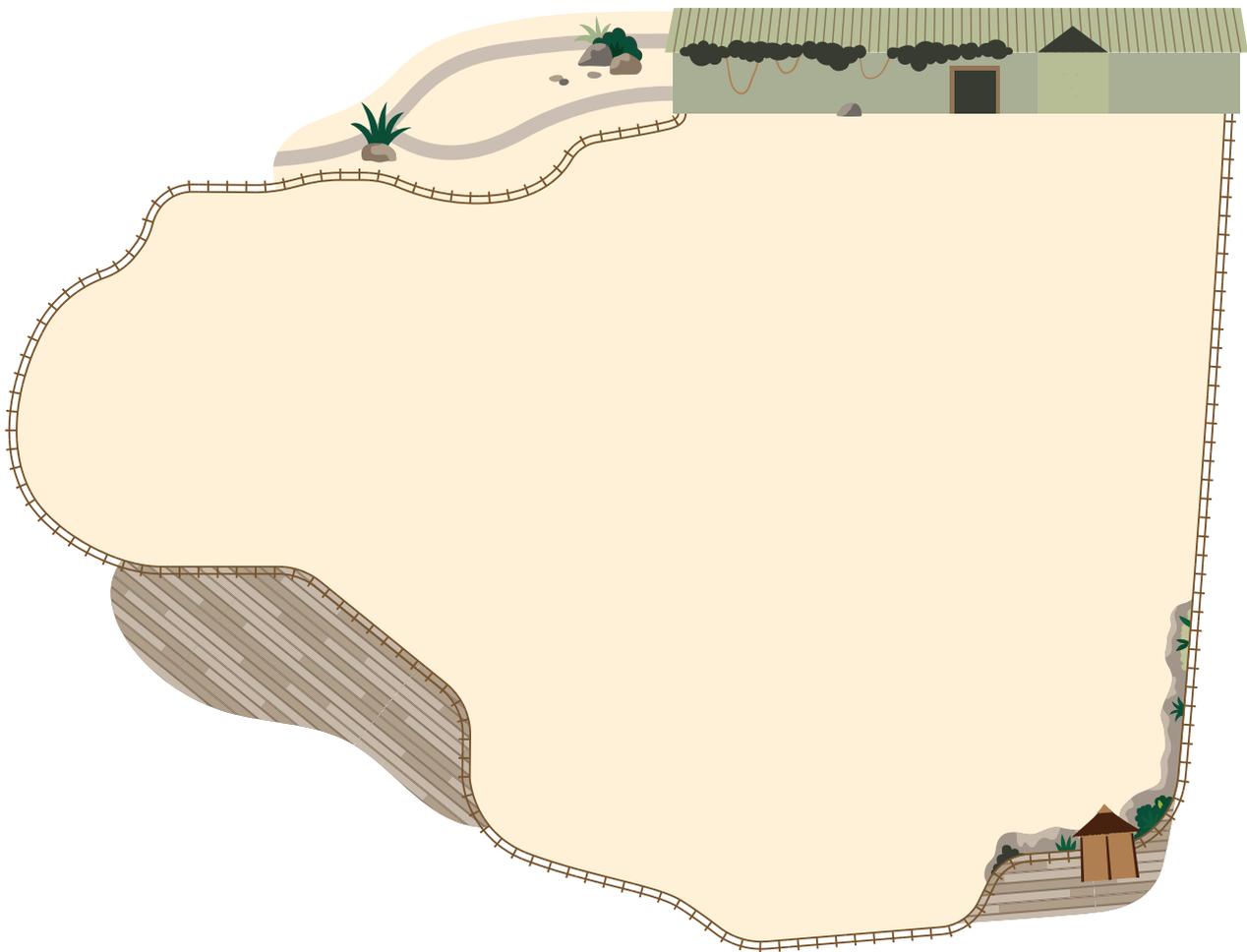


# Zoo Jobs: Habitat Designer Activity

# Habitat design

## Snow leopard - *Panthera uncia*



### Habitat needs

- Habitat needs to be large enough for two adult snow leopards
- Lots of rocks and steep areas
- High places where they can rest
- Caves, ledges, boulders, logs
- Some soil for digging
- Some grass, bushes, and trees
- Water – a small stream or shallow pool
- An inside area with straw and wood chippings
- An inside area with air conditioning to stay cool in the summer

- How will zoo guests be able to see this animal? Can you add guest viewing areas like windows or platforms?
- How will keepers be able to look after this animal? Can you add doors and paths for the keepers to use?
- How will keepers be able to feed this animal? Think about how this animal eats in the wild. What can you add to the habitat to help it eat naturally?

# Habitat design

## Sumatran orangutan - *Pongo abelii*



### Habitat needs

- Habitat needs to be large enough for six adult orangutans
- Lots of climbing structures
- High platforms where they can rest
- Trees, ropes, netting
- Soft soil or wood chipping for the floor
- Large trees
- Some bushes and grass
- Water – a small stream or shallow pool
- An inside area with heating to stay warm in the winter

- How will keepers be able to look after this animal? Can you add doors and paths for the keepers to use?
- How will keepers be able to feed this animal? Think about how this animal eats in the wild. What can you add to the habitat to help it eat naturally?

# Habitat design

Reticulated python - *Malayopython reticulatus*



## Habitat needs

- Habitat needs to be large enough for a 7-metre-long snake to stretch out
- Soft soil or wood chippings
- Low bushes and plants
- Large pool
- Areas to hide
- Heat lamps to keep warm
- UV lamps to replace natural sunlight

# Habitat design

## American flamingo – *Phoenicopterus ruber*



### Habitat needs

- Habitat needs to be large enough for 40 flamingos
- Large area of water with shallow and deep sections
- Large island
- Large areas of shallow mud for nest building
- Muddy or sandy banks
- Grass, bushes, trees
- Small pool of shallow water for feeding
- An inside area with heating to stay warm in the winter
